**RULES**

1. Read 4-H General Rules
2. Read 4-H Livestock, Equine & Small Animal Rules
3. Member must equip display cages on show day with litter box, litter, water, and a bottom liner (blanket/rug) for cat's traction. 4-H office will provide display cages.
4. No kittens under four months old will be allowed to show.
5. All cats must be on a halter and leash when outside of the cage.
6. Current, unexpired rabies vaccination information must be displayed on cage.
7. Cats in heat are barred from showing. Cats may or may not be neutered/spayed.
8. Exhibitor must be present to show cat during judging to be interviewed by judge.
9. Cat's toenails, front and back, must be clipped before entry.
10. To be a Colorado State Fair contestant in the Cat Show, the member must be a member in good standing and must have competed at the County Fair Cat Show.



**Cat Project members who intend to exhibit their animals at the Adams County Fair must complete the following to remain eligible for fair entry and exhibition:**

	Enroll in the Cat Project by enrollment deadline
	Complete and submit an Animal Care and Housing Form to the 4-H office by the deadline
	Vaccinate your cats: Rabies, FVRCP
	ID all animals and upload vaccination records in 4-HOnline by the deadline
	Keep record of your cat project in the Companion Animal Record Book
	Attend Animal Record Book Interviews and present an up-to-date Companion Animal Record Book with a green cover
	Enter fair classes online by the deadline
	Complete and turn in Companion Animal Record Book with a green cover by the Friday before Labor Day to the 4-H Office. If a record book is not completed for each species exhibited, the member will forfeit premiums/awards and be ineligible to exhibit that species at the next year's Fair.
