RULES

1. Read 4-H General Rules
2. Read 4-H Livestock, Equine & Small Animal Rules
3. Cavies must have an ear tag.
4. Exhibitor must supply their own cage/tub, water bottle, food bowl with food, and fresh vegetables/fruits.
5. No more than two cavies may be housed in the same cage/tub. The exception is in the 4-H Cavy Production Class.
6. All cavies must be brought to the judging table by the 4-H member or a designated representative. Cavies will be placed in the proper show cages according to ear tag. You may have a stand-in to exhibit your cavy only if you are involved in another 4-H function at the time of judging. Stand-in must be approved by the Superintendent.
7. Sharing of project animals is not permitted.



The Cavy Project is a county-only project. Projects are not eligible for Colorado State Fair. Cavy Project members who intend to exhibit their animals at the Adams County Fair must complete the following to remain eligible for fair entry and exhibition:

	Enroll in the Cavy Project by enrollment deadline
	Complete and submit an Animal Care and Housing Form to the 4-H office by the deadline
	ID all animals in 4-HOnline by the deadline
	Get your cavies tagged at our county clinic or elsewhere
	Keep record of your cavy project in the Companion Animal Record Book
	Attend Animal Record Book Interviews and present an up-to-date Companion Animal Record Book with a green cover
	Enter fair classes online by the deadline
	Complete and turn in Companion Animal Record Book with a green cover by the Friday before Labor Day to the 4-H Office. If a record book is not completed for each species exhibited, the member will forfeit premiums/awards and be ineligible to exhibit that species at the next year's Fair.

SHOWMANSHIP

Division: Cavy Showmanship

- Senior (member is 14 years and older)
- Intermediate (member is 11-13 years)
- Junior (member is 8-10 years)

All animals entered in Showmanship must be eligible for at least one additional class at the Adams County 4-H Cavy Show

DIVISION: ANIMAL SCIENCE DISCOVERY

- Class: Junior (8-10)
- Class: Intermediate (11-13)
- Class: Senior (14-18)

CAVY BREEDS

Divisions: Abyssinian, Abyssinian Satin, American, American Satin, Coronet, Peruvian, Peruvian Satin, Silkie, Silkie Satin, Teddy, Teddy Satin, Texel, White Crested

- Agouti (Silver Agouti, Golden Agouti, and Dilute Agouti)
- Marked (Broken Color, Tortoise Shell and White, Tortoise Shell, Himalayan, Dalmatian, and Dutch)
- Self (Black, Cream, Red, White, Beige, Chocolate, Lilac, Red-Eyed Orange)
- Solids (Roans, Brindles, Golden Solid, Silver Solid, and Dilute Solid)
- Tan Pattern (Black, Blue, Chocolate, and Lilac Tan Pattern)

- Junior – cavy up to four months old and weighing between 12-22 ounces.

Bring your photograph(s) to the Extension Office by Friday, July 24th by 4:30pm. Photographs can be either 3" x 5" or 5" x 7" color or black and white. Photographs must be placed in a standing picture frame for display at the fair. Limit one photograph per cavy entry. Name, age, and club name should be displayed on the back right bottom corner of each photograph.
