- If participant wants to bring their own horse, the horse must go through vet check: July 23rd between 4-7PM. In lieu of attending the scheduled health checks, a health certification issued within 7 days of arrival must be presented to the show office.
- Helmets are REQUIRED.

THURSDAY JULY 30

Open Mini Cattle Show 4-H Tent

- Before the 4-H Cattle Show
- Pre-entry for all bucket calves is required.
- Calves must be born between April 1 and June 1, of the current fair year.
- Exhibitor will be allowed to show only one calf.
- Bucket calf judging will be on child's ability to handle the calf.
- All calves must be on the bucket, bottle, or weaned at fair time (no nurse cows!)
- All calves must be halter broken.
- Calves may be of any breed or sex.
- All calves will be released immediately after the show.
- Fair rules and regulations on stalls, care of livestock, and health are to be adhered to.
- Bucket calves must go through a vet check on Tuesday July 28th 4:00-7:00PM, or have vet check paperwork within 7 days of show.

- After the 4-H Cavy Show

Open Mini Goat Show 4-H Tent

- Before the 4-H Goat Show
