

Custom Rates for Colorado Farms & Ranches in 2001

Agricultural operators may choose not to own all of the machinery and equipment necessary to perform every farm and ranch operation or to own all the land necessary for their livestock. In some cases, labor is not available. In other situations, owning the equipment is simply too costly for relatively small jobs. Therefore, many farms and ranches use custom operators and/or machinery rental to accomplish the needed operations.

A survey was sent to farmers, ranchers, machine operators, lenders, agricultural consultants, and Cooperative Extension faculty members throughout Colorado to determine rates charged in 2001 for various crop and livestock operations. The custom rates are reported for four general regions of Colorado.

Reported charges were used to determine a range of custom rate charges. "Most common" refers to the custom rate reported most often. "n/a" indicates that no information was available for that particular activity or the information was reported by a single source. Abnormally high and low charges were excluded from this report under the assumptions that the survey question was misinterpreted and/or there were atypical activities included in the charge.

The rates charged do not necessarily measure the full economic cost of performing the work specified. Some custom operators may charge only for the costs of fuel and labor. Other operators may charge for all costs including depreciation on equipment and allowance for risk. Field conditions, such as size, terrain, and location, may also account for some variations in rates charged.

The rates reported in this report are not recommended rates, but simply indicate rates currently being charged throughout Colorado. They represent a variety of working conditions, machine and equipment sizes, and farm and ranch operations. The reported rates reflect only the survey results and should be used only as a guide.

Reports in 2001 indicated the variable per bushel charge (second 12) for combining corn may be for bushels exceeding 30.
