


Custom Rates for Colorado Farms & Ranches in 2012

Colorado State University Extension annually conducts a survey of custom rates charged for various crop and livestock operations and lease arrangements in Colorado. Information is collected from agricultural producers, land owners and managers, lenders, agricultural consultants, machine operators, and Extension agents.

The survey results are reported by region:

- Northern generally those counties north of I-70 and east of the Rocky Mountains),
- Southern the area south of I-70 and the San Luis Valley, and
- Western generally those counties west of the mountains.



The rates reported in this report are not recommended rates, but simply indicate rates currently being charged throughout Colorado, as reported in the survey. The information in this report should be used only as a guide. Reported rates represent a variety of working conditions, machine and equipment sizes, and farm and ranch operations. They do not necessarily measure the full economic cost of performing the specified work. Also, field conditions, field size, terrain, and location account for some variations in rates charged.

Custom rates most commonly reported for 2012 were generally similar to those charged in 2011. Increased in charged rates are noted for certain operations within the sections of hay and silage harvesting, grain harvesting, and grape pruning and picking. Reported labor costs generally increased from 2011 to 2012.

Grain Harvesting In some locales there is both a fixed rate per acre and a variable rate per bushel charged for combining. For example, the costs for harvesting dryland wheat may be known as "23-23-23" or "3 23s" \$23 per acre plus \$0.23 for each bushel harvested in excess of 20 bushels per acre plus \$0.23 per bushel for hauling.
