

**Colorado State University Extension
Volunteer Driving Restriction**

We base approval for volunteers to drive on behalf of Extension programs on a number of factors including, but not limited to:

- volunteer application,
- references and interviews,
- the national background check results including the motor vehicle report, and
- any other driving history information

Although we look primarily at the most recent driving history, violations stay on your record for up to 10 years. An ongoing history of violations, serious driving violations, unsafe vehicle violations and license suspension or revocation in the past 7 years, may result in driving restrictions or denial of volunteer status.

Check Restrictions:

- Volunteer may only drive immediate family members to CSU Extension events.
- Volunteer may not make site visits on behalf of Extension programs.

I understand that these restrictions help to ensure the safety of Extension program participants. Colorado State University Extension reserves the right to refuse or revoke driving privileges and/or status of any volunteer at any time for any reason. This agreement will be in effect for the 20__ - 20__ programming year.
