

Summary of Major DM Changes - 2021

Extension Section (multiple screens)

- Number Completed
 - For Presentations, Media Appearances, and Guest Lectures, only 1 activity (presentation, media appearance, guest lecture) can be reported per entry.
- Demographics
 - Only report demographics when they have been self-reported by your participants. When working with youth in schools, you may use demographic data provided by the school rather than asking students themselves.”
 - Only one Activity Location (where the activity took place) can be entered at a time so that we can more accurately produce reports sorted by activity location.
 - A new field for Participant Location was added so that each county can have a record of participants from their county. Instead of using a location such as “statewide” for webinars, for example, you can report and track participants by county. (See [FAQ](#) for more information on how to report activity vs. participant location.)
- Issue Affiliation
 - A new dropdown for Issue Affiliation was added so that you can identify the issues you addressed through a given activity. This will allow us to aggregate activities by issue (diabetes prevention, regenerative agriculture, ecosystem sustainability, etc.) for continuous improvement and to better tell our story.
- Volunteer fields
 - All volunteer-related fields have been deleted, as we will no longer report activities conducted by our volunteers in DM. These activities can be reported in 4-H Online, the Volunteer Management System, etc.

Extension Impact

- Outcome indicators
 - New indicators for 2021 are organized by issue rather than by PRU. This will allow us to evaluate efforts and tell our story in a way that is more meaningful to communities than PRUs.

Extension Material Distribution

- Definition

The definition of what to report under this screen has been expanded to allow for distribution of electronic materials (e.g. e-newsletters) in addition to physical materials.
