Master's in Extension Education

Gain the skills and knowledge to develop impactful programs and deliver educational resources in your role as community educator. Designed for working professionals, the online Master of Extension Education program does not require a thesis, and all coursework is offered online. Interact and network with others across the country who are in Extension or similar agencies, so you can collaborate and gain insights from peers.

Graduate Certificate in Teaching in Extension

You will gain foundational knowledge and understanding of how to organize and effectively deliver education programs and events, such as county fairs, afterschool programs for kids on nutrition or STEM topics, or mitigating agricultural issues in communities.

Master's in Adult Education and Training

With coursework that is based in practice, yet grounded in current adult learning theory, this master's degree prepares you to successfully plan and administer a wide range of training and educational programs.

Facilitating Adult Learning Graduate Certificate

Learn how to teach adults using guidance strategies. This graduate certificate was designed for professionals who are already in training and education roles and would like to learn the tools and strategies to improve their facilitation skills.

Sustainable Community Development Noncredit Certificate

Offered in partnership with Village Earth, this program uses a multi-sector, participatory approach to learning. Rather than teaching prescriptive solutions to community problems, you learn how to use the community's input and vision to create options and solutions that truly meet community needs.

Online Courses

LSPA 300 - Reading and Writing for Communication - Spanish

Develop reading and writing proficiency through a thematic approach that focuses on communicative goals and utilizes tasked-based activities and assessments.

LSPA 345 - Business Spanish

Acquire the proper vocabulary to communicate in the business world and develop knowledge and sensitivity toward the Hispanic culture, increasing the appreciation of customs and attitudes regarding commerce.

LSPA 346 - Spanish for Health Care

Learn specialized terminology and certain grammar aspects of the language needed to communicate in medical situations.

LGBB 2002 - Spanish for Animal Health and Care Fields

Ideal for livestock farm managers and owners, veterinary professionals, or students studying related fields, you learn intermediate-level Spanish language skills to communicate about animal care.
