Fact sheet/publications committee

- Volunteers were solicited to review quality control, different modalities to publish and disseminate science-based information, peer-review, process, interactivity, etc.

PRU evolution

- Results of a survey of 13 western states were presented
- Gen Ponce-Pore led a discussion around the engagement collaboratives, including differentiation from the PRUs
- The group reviewed and added to a set of guiding principles to guide any evolution to a new program structure

PLT moving forward

- Blake spoke about the implications of moving to a new College unit, including establishing PLT as a standing committee
- The importance of subject matter reviews from colleagues like PRU leaders was discussed (in addition to supervisor contributions to performance reviews)

Community needs assessment

- Cary provided a status update and a potential vision for how PRUs might integrate information coming from the CNAs
- This could include a PRU leader retreat to prepare for more targeted, issue-based planning sessions at Forum
